DOG LICENSES

❖ Without a current dog license, it would be difficult to identify the owner of a lost dog. As a result, your pet may end up at the Vilas County Animal Shelter. Licensing your dog **is the law**. Wisconsin Statutes 174.05 requires every dog over the age of five (5) months to be licensed.

- ***Mail your current rabies certificate, along with a self addressed, stamped envelope and a check made payable to the Town of Washington to:***

- Dog license fees are \$10.00 for a male/female dog and \$5.00 for a neuter/spay dog.
- Fees must have a separate check from your taxes.
- Please be sure to purchase dog licenses by January 31 each year to ensure your dog is included in the report submitted to the county. Licenses expire on December 31 each year regardless of when purchased.
- A late fee of \$5.00 is collected for failure to obtain a license prior to April 1, or within 30 days of acquiring ownership of a licensable dog.
