Meeting Minutes:

1	Call to Order	Meeting called to order at 5:02 pm
2	Pledge of Allegiance	Recited by all
3	Verification of Postings	Sobralski stated the agenda was properly posted at the Wild Eagle Corner Store, MJ's Wayside, the Town Hall and on the Town's website. Local news media were notified more than 24 hours in advance.

5	Approval of the previous minutes from April 21, 2026	Motion - Linn Seconded – Granat All voting aye – Approved
6	Treasurer Report	Bolte presented the April 2026 treasurer's report
7	Town Foreman Report	All road limits will be removed on May 8. The brush site will be open for the season on Friday, May 8 at 4:00 pm. Town crew work included removing plow equipment from the trucks, tree and road clean up, and some road grading. No road sweeping due to dry weather conditions. Beaver activity on Lynx Lake and will be reported to our beaver remediation contact. Buoy installation needs to be scheduled but all buoys and equipment are staged. More quotes have come in for a new brush mechanism.

8	Vilas County Updates	<p>Pat Weber - pond hockey dates have been set - January 28 to 31, 2027.</p> <p>Holly Tomlanovich –building replacement discussions continue. Logging contract bids will be opened for June due dates. Riverside Park and fairground discussions will continue over the next several months. Grant discussions occurring with Land/Water Commission.</p>
9	Noise Ordinance	<p>Egan advised he received a citizen complaint regarding live music at a town business. A live music schedule is online, showing more frequent events planned for the summer. The citizen complaint is specific to music during evening hours and noted the effect on the residential neighborhood. Linn provided additional information about noise ordinances and noted that other municipalities have a public nuisance ordinance to address loud noises or unnecessary sound conditions. Vilas County does not have a noise ordinance. Egan will reach out to the business owner to discuss.</p>
