Meeting Minutes:

1	Call to Order	Meeting called to order at 5:15 pm
2	Pledge of Allegiance	Recited by all
3	Verification of Postings	Linn stated the agenda was properly posted at the Wild Eagle Corner Store, MJ's Wayside, the Town Hall and on the Town's website. Local news media were notified more than 24 hours in advance.
4	Approval of the agenda to be discussed in any order at the discretion of the Chairman	Motion - Linn Seconded – Granat All voting aye - Approved
5	Approval of the previous minutes from Meeting to Adjourn Board of Review and May Board Meeting from May 5, 2025	Motion - Linn Seconded – Granat All voting aye - Approved
6	Fire Truck Obligation	As discussed during the annual meeting, a resolution will be presented to the board in October 2025 to increase the tax levy for the fire truck purchase. The original amount was estimated at \$213,480.00, however, due to additional funding sources, our obligation has been reduced to \$201,267.00; due January 2026. The approved resolution and anticipated approval by town residents will occur at the November 2025 Special Elector meeting. This information is posted on the town website and in the town electronic newsletter.
7	Treasurer's Report	Bolte presented the May 2025 treasurer's report.
8	Town Foreman Report	During the month of May, roadside clean-up was completed, and brush site activity was high. On Chain O' Lakes Rd, there is a culvert plugging up due to beaver activity and Vilas County has been contacted for remediation. Four variance requests during the month of May. Road grading is almost done with the final stretch of Military Rd being done this week. Anvil Lake Rd culverts are almost complete, and rock crushing needs to be started in June. Insurance proceeds are received for the roof replacement, and we are waiting for written estimates. Road sweeping has been delayed due to dry weather

		conditions. Vilas County has a large blower on their equipment The town foreman will contact Vilas County to obtain information about the equipment that Vilas County uses as this might be a more cost-effective method rather than brushing - the yearly replacement cost for brushes is \$1600.
9	Professional Inspection of Old Garage	Due to the storm damage, Granat recommend we obtain a professional inspection for the old garage. Egan will contact RC Inspection Agency for assistance.
10	Outside Lighting for all Buildings	An electrician has been contacted and will provide an estimate for additional outside lighting of the town shop and town hall.
11	Plow Blade Restoration Update	Mike Faulkner was present at tonight's meeting and proposed he would volunteer to prep the plow for a fresh coat of paint, as well as perform a new picturesque scene on the plow. He will perform the work for the Town of Washington and be reimbursed for materials.
12	Buoy Program Update	Buoys, lights and cages have been installed. Linn contacted the City of Eagle River regarding providing additional manpower for buoy placement and removal. The City will continue to provide a worker for bi-annual buoy work. The City of Eagle River felt hiring a company for buoy placement and removal was not a cost-effective option.
