1	Call to Order	Meeting called to order at 5:15 pm
2	Pledge of Allegiance	Recited by all
3	Verification of Postings	Sobralski stated the agenda was properly posted at the Wild Eagle Corner Store, MJ's Wayside, the Town Hall and on the Town's website. Local news media were notified more than 24 hours in advance.

6	Treasurer Report	Bolte presented the May 2026 treasurer's report
7	Town Foreman Report	The town crew is behind schedule for road brushing and grading due to the dry weather. Linn did advise on theft issues with buoy lights and stickers being placed on various buoys. Finger Lake Ln road sign and stop sign were stolen over the past weekend. Firelane sign installations are up to date. Lynx Lake beaver situation still presents. Received one more quote for a new brush and mechanism – approximately \$22,000 with a 6-month lead time.

9	Eagle River Chamber Updates and Room Tax	Egan advises new chamber director was present at the last meeting. Due to change in leadership, a request for an audit of the books was submitted. Additionally, due to change in leadership, Egan is asking for 30% room tax reimbursement for the towns. Egan noted the Town of Washington contributes 55% of the commission money.
