1	Call to Order	Meeting called to order at 5:15 pm
2	Pledge of Allegiance	Recited by all
3	Verification of Postings	Sobralski stated the agenda was properly posted at the Wild Eagle Corner Store, MJ's Wayside, the Town Hall and on the Town's website. Local news media were notified more than 24 hours in advance.

6	Treasurer's Report	Bolte presented the November 2025 treasurer's report. Bolte also advised 2025 tax bills were mailed today.
7	Town Foreman Report	For the month of November, the crew was busy with snowplowing and sanding, including working on Thanksgiving Day. Work was performed on one of the plow trucks and repair work was approximately \$24,000. Due to weather and road priorities, work on re-addressing per the Vilas County ordinance will pause until Spring. Additionally, due to weather, beaver removal on Lynx Lake is paused. Smokey the Bear sign was put away for the year.
