A RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF A  
COMMUNITY WILDFIRE PROTECTION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Town of WASHINGTON recognizes the importance enhancing its ability to mitigate the potentially devastating impacts of wildfire as well as the importance of reducing the human suffering, property damage, interruption of public services and economic losses caused by wildfire; and

WHEREAS, wildfire poses a particular, significant, and ongoing threat to the Town of WASHINGTON; and

WHEREAS, community resiliency to wildfire depends on the preparedness levels of all stakeholders in the community – individuals, families, homeowner associations, community organizations, non-profits, businesses, and government; and

WHEREAS, by participating in the development of a Community Wildfire Protection Plan, the Town of WASHINGTON has an opportunity to influence where and how monies are spent on hazardous fuels reduction and can compete competitively for public funding to implement hazardous fuels reduction projects within the Town of WASHINGTON.
